"Light the Night" New Year's Eve was the 53rd TTT Saturday night in 2022. The year began and ended on Saturdays, focused on the theme: "Live by faith in the Son of God." We're grateful for all that God did during 2022, and prayerfully anticipating 2023.

The TTT vision continues: Every youth, before turning 20, to hear the Gospel with an invitation to "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ."

Please keep praying with us that the Gospel will be presented clearly and effectively each Saturday, that

youth will make the decision to personally "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ," and that those who know Christ will respond to the challenge to pray for and share the Gospel with others.

Pray for the teenagers, preteens, and adult leaders who are currently involved, and that more will be able to participate, in person and online.

February 11 is to be the first Leading Youth Day of 2023, providing peer evangelism and leadership training for students (ages 10-19) and adults. The plan is to have in person and online participation options available, reaching forward to multiply the mission: Telling The TRUTH to/through teenagers ... to win them to Christ and train them for Christ, teaching them how to share their faith through their local churches, on their campuses, throughout their communities, and into their world, wherever God leads them in their future.

You're invited to sing: "Christ through you can change the world, let Him be your guide. Christ you can change the world, stay close by His side. Though fierce the battle be, He'll give you victory. Just keep your flag of faith unfurled, you can change the world!"

During the nearly 57 years since TTT Christian Youth Ministries began, thousands have attended TTT Saturday nights and other outreaches, and hundreds have been trained in person at TTT to "do the work of an evangelist." They have come from all 50 states and 40 nations. Since the COVID-19 crisis began in March 2020, TTT continues

every Saturday night, in person and live-streamed through Facebook and www.TTTChristianYouth.org, also available on-demand.

Through Project Proclaim, many heard the Gospel in 2022. They have seen and will continue to see the message "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ" on billboards and at county fairs and street festivals. Copies of God's ABCs are sent upon request to

listeners of Telling The TRUTH daily radio, broadcast on 58 radio stations in 14 states, and via podcast. And TTT NKJV Bibles can be received by 10-19 year-olds.

As we wrapped up 2022 on Saturday, Dec. 31, viewers from at least 11 states and 10 nations have connected, including Australia, Brazil, Cambodia, Canada, Colombia, New Zealand, South Africa, Thailand, Venezuela and Zambia. The 2023 theme: "reaching forward." *"Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers through whom you believed, as the Lord gave to each one? I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase. As 2023 began, "good reports" included 12 new believers responding to the Gospel the Wednesday before Christmas. Sunday morning (New Year's Day), a young lady who had heard the Gospel during the summer and fall approached her pastor, saying, "I want to be saved," and he was privileged to lead her to Jesus.

The song by Wayne Watson, "For Such a Time as This" spells it out effectively: "Now, all I have is now to be faithful, to be holy, and to shine, lighting up the darkness. Right now, I really have no choice but to voice the truth to the nations, a generation looking for God. For such a time as this I was placed upon the earth, to hear the voice of God and

do His will, whatever it is. For such a time as this, for now and all the days He gives, I am here, I am here, and I am His, for such a time as this."

TTT Saturday nights are continuing week by week. February 4 (God willing) is to be TTT's 57th birthday and the 2,975th consecutive Saturday.

The first 2023 "Leading Youth" Day, providing biblical and practical youth evangelism training and resources for 10-19 year-old students and adult youth workers as coaches is to be available at TTT Saturday, February 11 (with in person and online participation options planned).

When more youth and adults are trained and prepared, many more unreached youth can hear the Gospel, turn to Jesus from their sins, and receive God's gift of eternal life.

Let's press on, that we may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold (Philippians 3:12).

You are invited to personally believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and share your faith.

Let's be reaching forward together for such a time as this.
