

I first attended TTT as a North High School student from Bethel Temple, with our youth pastor, Dave Schwambach. I was quite shy. TTT was just getting started, meeting in the basement. I attended regularly during my high school years, and have kept in touch and attended occasionally since. I remember Big Splattt, Burger Bash, Faith Festival, Tween Tours, and Fair Share, and working alongside Carol Harris (now Youngs) and Stan Diekmann.

One event that stands out in my memory was during an event at the Vanderburgh County 4-H Auditorium. We had rigged up a series of ropes, pulleys, and a model airplane, which I was supposed to fly and descend to a landing. Unfortunately, the unnamed person in charge of the stunt cut the wrong rope, which left the airplane suspended upside down with me inside, hanging on for dear life to keep from falling head first. Thank God I was successfully rescued.

George and I share a common interest in aviation. I bought a Cessna 150 and got my pilot’s license in my twenties. George was one of my first passengers. I still fly, although not as much as I used to.

My daughter Christina helped with Fair Share as a teenager.

I worked in accounting in the Army Reserve, and as an Army nurse, and keep my LPN license active to do volunteer medical-related work. Since retiring, I have served on short-term missions trips in Ukraine, Guatemala, Myanmar, Thailand, and Brazil. My wife, Patricia, and I are currently on one such trip in Thailand.

I am celebrating 60 years of TTT’s positive influence on my life. My small church in Evansville had no youth group and TTT met that need. I started coming in 1966 as a high school freshman. I hardly ever missed a Saturday night.

TTT’s electric atmosphere, enthusiastic young adult leaders, & George’s simple gospel messages drew me in. The personal stories & testimonies shared by others inspired & motivated me to better know & serve Jesus. I have many special TTT memories: the giant egg toss, burger bash, 4-H fairs, attending the Bill Glass crusade, etc.

A highlight was traveling to Winona Lake, Indiana to the 25th Anniversary Celebration of Youth for Christ International. It was reported that between 8,000 & 10,000 persons attended. I heard Billy Graham and sang in a huge choir with Kurt Kaiser. I heard 3 triplet girls sing. I also observed the budding romance of one of our college leaders with one of the triplets (whom he later married)!

Just as TTT is celebrating 60 years of God’s faithfulness, so am I. In 1974, I graduated in Elementary Education from Georgetown College. In 1976, I received a Religious Education degree from Southern Baptist Seminary. From 1977-2000, I served as Minister of Childhood Education at First Baptist Church in DeRidder, LA.

Since retiring, I teach in our church’s pre-school and Sunday School. I am blessed to use my spiritual gift of teaching and natural talents to minister to boys, girls, parents, fellow teachers & others.
